

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS; MINUTES OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, OHIO, REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING AT 7:00 P.M., NOVEMBER 7, 2019, AT THE FIREHOUSE.

The regular meeting of the Village of Lewisburg, Ohio Council was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Marsha Jones.

ROLL CALL: Eliza Wagoner, Clerk of Council.

PRESENT: Mayor Marsha Jones, Council Members Belinda Harry, Mark Madigan, Ted Thies, and Chad Woodworth. Lori Pheanis and Dennis Roberts were absent. Also, present were Municipal Manager Jeff Sewert, Law Director Rick Faber, and Police Chief Rick McGee.

Motion to approve the minutes of the October 17, 2019, regular Village Council Meeting. First by Mark Madigan. Second by Chad Woodworth. Roll Call vote: 5 Yes 0 No. Motion approved.

CITIZENS: Adam Craft introduced himself as a candidate for County Commissioner for 2020. Representative J. Todd Smith discussed the Preble County Patriots' Parkway Route and was pleased to learn that Lewisburg had already passed the Resolution.

MAYOR: Mayor Jones stated that the Harvest Fest went well, the Ways and Means Committee had been developing plans for healthcare benefits for Village employees, and the Levy had passed.

Mayor Jones stated that a Planning Commission Meeting is being proposed for November 21st at 5:30 p.m., and a Charter Review Meeting is being proposed for November 25th at 5:30 p.m.

MUNICIPAL MANAGER: Manager Sewert gave updates on leaf collection, waste water treatment plant sludge hauling, curb appeal program, vehicle purchases planned for 2020, and the need for some more part-time service department employees.

POLICE: Chief McGee stated he had received a Letter of Resignation from Officer Brandon Reaman.

Chief McGee stated the department had recently done a safety check at the school checking to see if all passengers were properly wearing their seat belts.

PARK: Ted Thies reported the Park Board discussed the need for cameras at the park to help deter theft.
