RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION

Mrs. Belinda Harry moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Brown Memorial Library, a municipal public library of the Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio; therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio (as the appropriate taxing authority), two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the Brown Memorial Library, a municipal public library of the Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio, for the purpose of current expenses of said Brown Memorial Library, a municipal public library of the Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio, per Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.23 and other applicable law, noting the Preble County Auditor's Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue attached as Exhibit "A", at a rate not exceeding 1.00 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.10 or ten cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five years, and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy of 1.00 mills, with the renewal levy commencing in tax year 2015, first due and/or collected in calendar year 2016, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio, at the 2015 general election to be held at the usual voting places within said Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio, on the 3rd day of November, 2015; and be it further

RESOLVED, That this renewal tax levy, if approved by the electors, is necessary to the proper furnishing and rendering of free public library services in and for the residents of the Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio; and be it further

RESOLVED, That said levy be placed upon the tax list of the appropriate tax year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Council of the Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio, be and she is hereby directed to forthwith certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Preble County, Ohio, and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.



CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED PROPERTY TAX REVENUE

(Use this form when a taxing authority certifies a millage rate and requests the revenue produced by that rate.)

The County Auditor of PREBLE County, Ohio, does hereby certify the following:

- 1. On April 17, 2015, the taxing authority of the **VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG/ BROWN MEMORIAL LIBRARY** certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted on April 16, 2015, requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by **(ONE)** mills to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation for **CURRENT EXPENSE** purposes pursuant to **Revised Code Section 5705.23**, to be placed on the ballot at the **GENERAL ELECTION NOV. 3, 2015**. The levy type is a **RENEWAL** for a **5 year term**.
- 2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$ **27,460** per year for 100 % collection.
- 3. The total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$ **27,460,780**

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. "Total tax valuation" includes the taxable value of all real property in the subdivision, which are on the tax lists that were most recently certified for collection and estimates of the taxable value of personal and public utility per personal property for the first year the levy will be collected as set forth on the worksheets prescribed in conjunction with this form. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor (where the greatest taxable value of the subdivision is located) shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
- 2. For purposes of the certification, "subdivision" includes any agency, board, commission or other authority authorized to request a taxing authority to submit a tax ley on its behalf.
- 3. "Levy type" includes the following: (1) additional, (2) renewal, (3) renewal with an increase, (4) renewal with a decrease, (5) replacement, (6) replacement with an increase, and (7) replacement with a decrease levies.
- 3. Please file this certificate with the subdivision as soon as possible, so the taxing authority can pass a resolution to proceed not later than 90 days before the election.
