

RESOLUTION NO. 2015 - 09

A RESOLUTION TO COMMIT AN ADDITIONAL \$52,000 IN MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2016-2017 FOR A CDB GRANT THROUGH THE PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, COMMISSIONERS FOR DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION ACTIVITIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

That Whereas, a CDB grant is potentially available through the office of the Preble County, Ohio, Commissioners for downtown revitalization;

And Whereas, Resolution No. 2015-04 was passed on March 19, 2015 to apply for said grant and to commit \$85,000.00 in matching funds from the budget for calendar year 2016 along with \$58,000.00 in-kind services consisting of labor and equipment;

And Whereas, an additional \$52,000.00 in matching funds may now be required from the Village of Lewisburg to receive said grant;


And Whereas, the project is in the best interest of the citizens of Lewisburg, Ohio;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an additional "not to exceed" amount of \$52,000.00 of funds from the Village of Lewisburg, Ohio, are hereby authorized to be budgeted for calendar year 2016 in order to assist in the downtown revitalization project.

Section 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage to meet the Community Development Block Grant Deadline.
