

School Resource Officer

Village of Lewisburg

The Village of Lewisburg has a position open in its Police Department for a full-time School Resource Officer/Patrol Officer. The person in this position is responsible for law enforcement, crime prevention and education.

Qualifications: Applicants must be 21 years old; OPOTA certified; possess a valid Ohio driver's license; possess a high school diploma or G.E.D.; must not have been convicted of the following: any felony, any crime involving moral turpitude, any crime involving children or minors, domestic violence, any crime involving illegal substances, or any crime involving perjury or false statements. Must possess good moral character. If a former member of the military, must have been honorably discharged. Must also provide proof of U.S. Citizenship.

Status: Full-Time, Non-Exempt, with full Benefits.
