

**RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS; MINUTES OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, OHIO, REGULAR COUNCIL MET AT 7:30 P.M., JUNE 19, 2014 AT THE FIREHOUSE**

Roll Call at 7:30

Members present: Mayor Putnam, Mark Madigan, Belinda Harry, Dennis Roberts, Marsha Jones and Jackie Sewert.

Mayor Putnam had no report.

Municipal Manager Jeff Sewert requested a budget workshop meeting prior to the July 17 Village Council meeting and beginning at 6:30 p.m. Mark Madigan made a motion to have a budget workshop on July 17 and beginning at 6:30 p.m. and Dennis Roberts seconded, all in favor.

Municipal Manager Jeff Sewert presented a financial agreement from Farmers State Bank located at 100 North Commerce Street, Lewisburg, Ohio. Municipal Manager Sewert stated this will allow the Village to utilize the bank for utility bill collection and other Village banking needs. Dennis Roberts made a motion to enter into the financial agreement with Farmers State Bank and Mark Madigan seconded, all in favor.

Municipal Manager asked Village Council to approve the advertising of the bidding dates for the Clay Street Reconstruction project on June 26 and July 2, 2014 and open the bids on July 10, 2014. Belinda Harry made a motion to advertise for the Clay Street Reconstruction project and Mark Madigan seconded, all in favor.

Fire Chief Sewert reported on the new Pratt facility and that the start up of the facility went very well. Police Chief McGee reported that Officer Andrew Johnson is currently in class to become a Fire Arms Instructor.

Police Chief McGee reported that there has been a recent rise in criminal activity within the Village. Library Liaison Jackie Sewert reported on the summer reading program. There has been great attendance this year with over 100 children signed up.

Park Liaison Mark Madigan reported items from the recent Park Board meeting. Projects forthcoming are staining the gazebo and footbridge, cleaning of debris along Salem Road and resealing the Tillman Lane walking path.

Mark Madigan reported on the upcoming activities sponsored by the Tri-County North Community Association.

Belinda Harry made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Jackie Sewert seconded, all in favor. The meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
