

ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 03

**ORDINANCE REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY SECTION 133.07 OF THE
CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF LEWISBURG, OHIO, DEALING WITH
PHOTOCOPY FEES FOR VILLAGE PUBLIC RECORDS**

That Whereas, the Village Municipal Manager has adopted a Public Records Request Policy that makes Section 133.07 of the Lewisburg Codified Ordinances unnecessary;

And Whereas, changes in Ohio Public Records laws and various Court cases suggest that some of the provisions of Section 133.07 of the Lewisburg Codified Ordinances (which Section was adopted in 1996) are archaic and no longer appropriate;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Section 133.07 of the Codified Ordinances of Lewisburg, Ohio, currently reads as per the attached Exhibit "A".

Section 2. Section 133.07 of the Codified Ordinances of Lewisburg, Ohio, is herein repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective 30 days after its passage by Council.

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133.07 PHOTOCOPYING FEE.

(a) Village public officials, employees and personnel shall have access to free copying of appropriate Village public records used in the normal course of their work duties for the Village.

(b) For all requests for copies of appropriate and releasable Village public records other than those in subsection (a) hereof, a fee of one dollar (\$1.00) per page shall be paid by the applicant for said public records before the Fiscal Officer shall make said copies available for pick-up by the applicant. Persons requesting one copy of a single Village ordinance or resolution less than six pages in length shall be exempt from this fee.

(c) The Fiscal Officer shall keep an appropriate record of all fees collected under this section that is satisfactory to meet State auditing requirements. (Ord. 1996-19. Passed 12-19-96.)
