

ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 06

**ORDINANCE REGARDING THE NAMING OF NEW VILLAGE STREETS
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO,
MUNICIPAL LIMITS UPON AND AFTER AN ANNEXATION BY SAID VILLAGE**

That Whereas, new Village streets or continuations of already existing Village streets are often created when the Village annexes additional land into its municipal limits;

And Whereas, it is useful and appropriate for the Village to name all new streets or continuations of already existing streets;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Upon and after the annexation of land by the Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio, any new street that is not a continuation of an already existing Village street shall keep the same street name that it had prior to annexation.

Section 2. Upon and after the annexation of land by the Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio, any continuation of an already existing Village street shall have its name changed to (if not already identical to) the already existing Village street that it is a continuation of.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
