

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-11

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE RECODIFICATION, EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, OHIO.

THAT WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Lewisburg, Ohio;

WHEREAS, numerous sections in the Traffic and General Offenses Codes need to be amended or enacted in order to conform with State law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The recodification, editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Lewisburg, Ohio, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances, to wit:

Section 2: The following sections of the Traffic and General Offenses Codes, as amended, are hereby approved and adopted as amended or enacted so as to conform to enactments of the Ohio General Assembly.

Section 3: The complete text of the Traffic and General Offenses Code sections listed above are set forth in full in the 2018 replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances which are hereby attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A. Any summary publication of this ordinance shall include a complete listing of these sections. Notice of adoption of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new matter contained therein.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Lewisburg, Ohio, and for the further reason of the lack of local ordinances to enforce newly amended or enacted sections in the Traffic and General Offenses Codes. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
