

ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 01

**ORDINANCE ADOPTING A NEW SECTION 139.18 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF LEWISBURG, OHIO, ENTITLED "EMERGENCY ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSE ACTION".**

That Whereas, it is useful and appropriate for the Village of Lewisburg, Ohio, to have a cost schedule that can be periodically updated without additional legislation, and yet, will be comparable to the cost schedule contemplated by the Preble County Fire Chiefs' Association, all for purposes governed by Section 3745.13 of the Ohio Revised Code involving liability for costs of dealing with an unauthorized spill, release, or discharge;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** A new Section 139.18 of the Codified Ordinances of Lewisburg, Ohio, is herein adopted to read as follows:


**139.18 EMERGENCY ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSE ACTION.**

Whenever Village of Lewisburg, Ohio, equipment and/or personnel respond to/for emergency action contemplated under Ohio Revised Code §3745.13, the responsible party/wrongdoer shall pay the Village of Lewisburg, Ohio, a sum of money according to the most current special response cost summary approved by the Preble County Fire Chiefs' Association that is on file with the Clerk of Council of the Village of Lewisburg, Ohio, and in addition shall pay to the Village of Lewisburg, Ohio, the replacement cost for all Village property damaged, destroyed, or consumed at the scene of the emergency, if said property is not specifically listed on said cost summary.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

### ORC 3745.13. Liability for costs of dealing with unauthorized spill, release or discharge.

When emergency action is required to protect the public health or safety or the environment, any person responsible for causing or allowing an unauthorized spill, release, or discharge of material into or upon the environment or responsible for the operation of an illegal methamphetamine manufacturing laboratory that has caused contamination of the environment is liable to the municipal corporation, county, township, countywide emergency management agency amended, may be applied to the type of material involved and the conditions of the spill, release, discharge, or contamination, that person is liable for those costs only if the political subdivision, countywide agency, or regional authority employed those criteria and methods in its emergency action.
