

RESOLUTION NO. 2019- 09

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED FOR THE NORTHEAST SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, FOR THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, OHIO**

**WHEREAS**, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Lewisburg is planning to make capital improvements to the Northeast Sanitary Sewer Improvements Project, and

**WHEREAS**, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** The Village of Lewisburg, Ohio, approves filing an application and related forms for financial assistance with the Ohio Public Works Commission, for the Lewisburg – Northeast Sanitary Sewer Improvements Project.

**Section 2:** The Municipal Manager, Jeff Sewert, is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

**Section 3:** The Municipal Manager, Jeff Sewert is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

**Section 4:** The Village of Lewisburg, Ohio, does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project.

**Section 5:** The Village of Lewisburg, Ohio, hereby authorizes Kramer & Associates, LLC to assist the Village of Lewisburg in its application process and in the engineering of the project.

**Section 6:** This Resolution shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
